

## Bruges Belgium

A quiet site set in woodland and just a short walk from the wonderful sights of ancient Bruges. We were surprised to find it along a leafy suburban street with bungalows opposite. Open all year, this site was very busy in August. An entrance with automatic barrier leads to a friendly reception where English is spoken. Also here are toilets and a separate single shower for each sex. A motorhome service point is located nearby. A seasonal snack bar is adjacent, along with cycle hire and free use of a chest freezer.

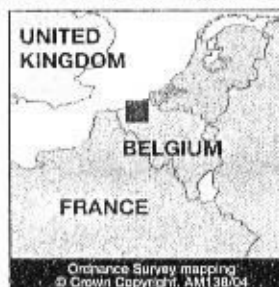
Opposite is a small car park and another shower block, where the showers are hot, free and the floor is heated. There is a wash-up and vegetable preparation facility nearby, as well as a chemical disposal point.

The gravel roads lead to 110 flat, open grass pitches with electric hook-ups. Most of the site is surrounded by mature woodland.

Nearby are a supermarket, baker's, filling station, fast food outlet and swimming pool.

#### How to get there

Take exit 8 from the E40/A10 motorway towards Bruges (Brugge). Turn right on to the N397, and when you reach the rail station, pass under the tunnel. At the island, turn right towards Maldegem. Turn right again at the traffic lights (again to Maldegem) on to the N9 and, at the second set of lights (opposite McDonalds), turn right then immediately left. The site is on the right.

#### Nearby attractions

Bruges, with its historic centre to explore on foot, in a horse-drawn carriage, by bus or boat; specialities including lace and chocolate, numerous street cafés
